

PRIVACY POLICY & DATA COLLECTION

Cornerstone Events is committed to protecting your privacy and handling personal information securely and transparently, in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles.

Cornerstone Events does not sell personal information and does not use personal information for unrelated marketing purposes.

Why we ask for your consent

To ensure you are fully informed prior to submitting your personal information.

What information we collect

We only collect personal information that is reasonably necessary to manage event registrations and deliver our services. Sensitive information is collected only where required and is handled with additional security safeguards.

How we use your information

Your information is used solely to:

- Process and manage your event registration
- Deliver event-related services and communications

Sharing your information

To deliver events, limited personal information may be shared with trusted third parties, subject to confidentiality and privacy obligations. These may include:

- Hotels and travel or logistics providers
- Conference venues (e.g. dietary or accessibility requirements)
- Conference sponsors (optional and opt-out available)
- Event apps and technology providers
- Payment processors
- Client-appointed event management personnel

Data storage and security

We take reasonable steps to protect personal information from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, or disclosure, including:

- Secure cloud-based systems
- Role-based access controls
- Password protection and system permissions
- Secure disposal of paper records

Data retention

Personal information is retained only as long as necessary:

- Event data is anonymised within 12 months after the event unless required otherwise
- Electronic and paper records are securely deleted or destroyed when no longer needed
- Non-identifiable data may be retained for reporting and analytics

Your rights

You may request access to or correction of your personal information at any time. Privacy enquiries or complaints are handled promptly and confidentially.
